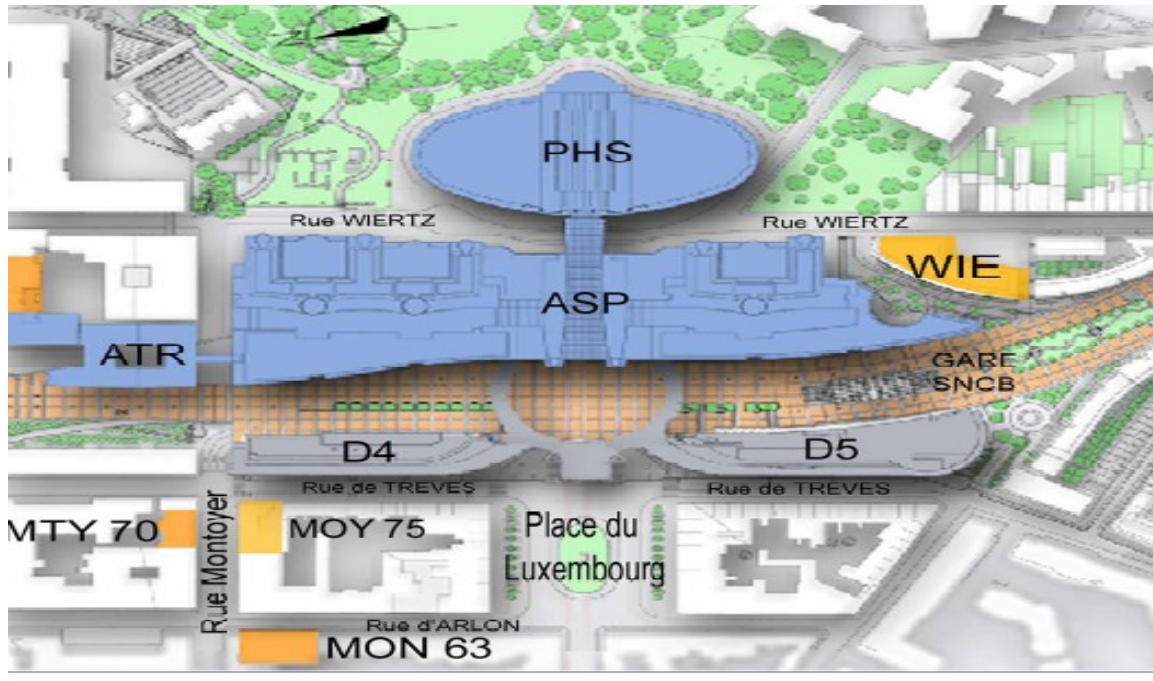
by Bus: No 95&96 from the city centre (**Bourse**) to Place du Luxembourg
