

FIDH is seeking to recruit a high-level legal expert for the Business, Human Rights and Environment Desk to follow the United Nations negotiations of a *Legally Binding Instrument to regulate transnational corporations and other business enterprises*.

**Specific objectives of the consultancy:**

1. Advocate for an ambitious treaty based on FIDH's legal analysis of the Updated Draft during the intersessional consultations and the 11<sup>th</sup> session of negotiations which will be held in Geneva on October 20-24<sup>th</sup>, 2025.
2. Encourage States to contribute constructively to the informal thematic consultations and to the 11<sup>th</sup> session of the OEIGWG negotiations of a Legally Binding Instrument.
3. Refine FIDH's legal position on key contentious elements of the Updated Draft following the negotiations during the 10<sup>th</sup> session last December 2024 and the discussions in the upcoming intersessional consultations.
4. Contribute to the collective advocacy efforts by other civil society organisations and networks such as ESCR-Net, Feminists for a Binding Treaty, and the International and European Treaty Alliance – of which FIDH is a member.
